

Weapons (Policy 5014)

All students, staff, and visitors are prohibited from possessing, storing, making, or using a weapon at school or on or in any school property, including leased or owned facilities or vehicles, or at any school-sponsored activity or event.

A “weapon” is any object which, in the manner in which it is used, is intended to be used, or is represented, is capable of inflicting serious bodily harm or property damage, as well as endangering the health and safety of persons. Weapons include, but are not limited to, firearms (including, but not limited to, firearms as defined in 18 U.S.C. 921(a)(3)), guns of any type whatsoever, including air and gas-powered guns (whether loaded or unloaded), knives (subject to the exceptions below), razors with unguarded blades, clubs, electric weapons, metallic knuckles, martial arts weapons, chemical agents, ammunition, and explosives.

All students, staff, and visitors are also prohibited from possessing, storing, making, or using objects which resemble weapons such as cap guns or water guns.

Anyone who violates this policy will be subject to discipline according to the Kenosha High School of Technology Enhanced Curriculum Code of Conduct and referred to law enforcement, as appropriate.
